If you choose not to pursue or participate in an investigation or disciplinary proceeding, it's important that you know that you may request further conduct action at any future time, consistent with Blinn's policy. Of course, the longer the period of time elapsed from the time of the incident you reported, the more difficult it will be to obtain information as individuals graduate or leave school or physical evidence is no longer obtainable. However, this does not mean that a fair hearing is impossible. If you choose not to share all the information you have about the incident it will limit our investigation. You are encouraged to meet with our office at any time to discuss options, and you may, of course, be accompanied by an adviser or advocate of your choice who is a Blinn College faculty, staff or student and not legally trained.

We would also like to make you aware that Blinn College's legal obligation is to investigate all reports of sexual discrimination, harassment, misconduct and/or violence and that Blinn College will investigate to the extent of the information available to it.

If you need additional support during this time in the form of counseling support, alternative housing options, or academic accommodations, please contact our office so that we can work with you in a timely way to provide assistance.
